

Keep to the boundary wall until you reach a small metal gate on to the Golf Course. Keep left around the boundary until you reach a metal gate below the 15th tee. Go down hill over a stile; now keeping the fence to the right make your way through bracken and nettle to a a gate and stile in this fence.

Turn right and follow waymarkers through some fields on to a farm track. When it bends left look for steps on the right. Go up, through the gate and by a stone wall until a gate leads to the Church graveyard. Go across to the road OS 066602.



7a) You can turn left down hill to get to the far end of the Lake and stroll to the right or left around the Lake to the facilities.

7b) Cross the road to a gate by a finger post and follow an at first faint path down hill and then through some gorse bushes to a wooden gate on the left which takes you into woodland. There is a choice of paths down to the Lake. We suggest turn left and enjoy the trees as you go along the hill slope gradually down hill and at last down steps to the Lakeside where you can turn right or left to reach the facilities OS 064605.

Walk 3: OS Map Explorer 200 Llanelwedd to Llandrindod

Llanelwedd can be reached by public transport (check www.traveline.cymru or 0871 2002 233) and is just outside Builth Wells on the A483. The walk is graded as Moderate to Hard because of some steep climbs. It finishes at Llandrindod Lake where there is parking, toilets and cafe. This is a varied walk with a long section on open high ground, bracken covered. In the summer and autumn bracken and nettles can reach 6 ft high. There are fine views over the Wye and Ithon valleys. Wear strong shoes or hiking boots and take waterproofs and emergency rations just in case!

1) From the bus stop turn back towards Llandrindod. As you have to go 50m up the main road with no footpath, cross over and walk on the wide verge until you reach the CCTV mast. There is now a footpath on the other side of the road leading past the entry to the Bridle Path OS 048518, and you can cross back.



The OS map is of little help as the paths have been altered. So follow the waymarkers up the hill to Waengowan Farm. Go through the metal gate with a waymarker post on your left SO 057524.



2) After 200m the track turns sharp right then left towards a gate leading to open hillside. Follow the grassy track round the side of a hill as it goes past a fenced off patch of discoloured grass with a smell of bad eggs the site of Sulphur Springs. Continue on the grassy path until you come to a shallow valley.

3a) Across the valley you can see a Cairn. There is no footpath but you can make your way to the Cairn and then go due north till you reach a ravine. Make your way down into the ravine and turn right following a small stream to Cwm Berwyn Holiday Cottages.

3b) Keeping to the main route you go ahead along the edge of the open ground and then turn right and downhill to Cwm Berwyn Holiday Cottages OS 079548.

4) Go through the Cottages and out on to a Road. Turn left and go downhill to Cefn Bychan. Turn right into the farm yard and out through an iron gate on the opposite side. Follow the iron fence on your left through a farm gate on your left. Here go to the right and follow the track uphill to another gate. Do not go through this gate but turn almost round in a circle to the left and follow the track round the hillside of Castle Bank. Cross the saddle and keep to the track towards the road. Bear left up hill with the road on the right and a field boundary on the left.



5) To the right of the site of an ancient Quarry, now used for offroad parking, a farm track jjoins the road on the right. Take this track which is a public right of way for walkers, and after 2k go through a farm gate. Continue uphill until you reach a farm gate on your right. Turn downhill on a faint track until you come to a T-junction. Turn right and keep on past Carregwiber and a bungalow to a road. Follow the road uphill until you reach a turning on the left.. Turn lleft and in 200m there is a stile on the right OS 078593

6) Go uphill towards the wind turbine. Cross a stile to the right of the trees and go up to a field gate again at the end of trees. Follow the boundary wall on the left through another gate.
